### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE**

### 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- **1.1** These general terms and conditions of sale ("<u>General Terms</u>") describe the terms on which BOTTEGA VENETA FRANCE, a simplified joint-stock company incorporated under the laws of France, with a share capital of 159.750,00€, with registered office at 28 rue Boissy d'Anglas, 75008 Paris, France, registered with the French Register of Commerce of Paris under number RCS Paris 696920545, with VAT number FR76696920545, subject to the management and coordination of Kering Holland NV ("<u>Bottega Veneta</u>", "<u>we</u>", "<u>us</u>", "<u>our</u>"), sells, and a customer ("<u>you</u>", "<u>your</u>") purchases, the limited edition of the Sacco lounge chair by Zanotta (designed in 1968 by Piero Gatti, Cesare Paolini and Franco Teodoro) commissioned and reinterpreted by Matthieu Blazy for Bottega Veneta which merges the fluidity of form of the original Sacco with animal forms to evoke creativity, wonder, and boundless imagination, used in the setting of the Bottega Veneta Summer 25 fashion show ("<u>Product/s</u>") through the website <a href="https://www.bottegaveneta.com/en-fr/">https://www.bottegaveneta.com/en-fr/</a> ("<u>Website</u>"), along with your right of withdrawal/cancellation and returns of the Products, whether applicable.
- **1.2** These General Terms will apply to any contract for the sale of Products by Bottega Veneta to you through the Website ("**Contract**").
- 1.3 The sale of Products under these General Terms is available to both professionals (meaning any natural or legal person who is acting for purposes related to its trade, business or profession, or its intermediary) and consumers, meaning natural persons who act for purposes of personal consumption (i.e. for purposes extraneous to their trade, business, craft and profession and not for profit), who have reached the age of majority and have full legal capacity to enter into a Contract, in their country. The Product is an armchair intended for use as a piece of furniture in a (private) residential setting. Any use of the Products beyond its permitted residential use shall be avoided. It is not a product designed for children.
- **1.4** You will be asked to agree to these General Terms and to the Terms of Use of the Website ("<u>ToU</u>") before placing an order. We therefore advise you to read these documents carefully, and in particular these General Terms, before proceeding with any purchase, and save or print a copy for future reference. If you do not agree to these General Terms, the ToU and our Privacy Policy, you will not be able to order any Products from the Website.
- **1.5** We reserve the right to amend or update all or part of these General Terms from time to time. We will always post the most current version of these General Terms on the Website and display the "Last Updated" date to reflect the date of the changes. The terms applicable to your order are the terms in effect on the date of your order. The amended terms will apply to orders placed subsequently.

#### 2. PRODUCTS INFORMATION AND AVAILABILITY

- **2.1** Information on the Products (along with the corresponding Products codes) and relevant prices are available on the Website and on these General Terms.
- 2.2 Pictures of the Products displayed on the Website may not correspond to the Products actual appearance. In particular, the colors, fabric, shade, grain, texture of the Products shown on your screen may vary from those of the actual Products. Therefore, you shall rely exclusively on the description of the Products and their characteristics as mentioned on the Website. In particular: **Products have been used in the setting of the Bottega Veneta**

Summer 25 fashion show. Each Product is part of a limited-edition collection. The craftsmanship of each Product, making each piece in the series a unique achievement of design, made with a production process that guarantees its authenticity and originality and Products are, by their nature, subject to being imperfect. Any discrepancies in the purchased Product, in the colors, fabric, shade, grain, texture, compared to the picture displayed in Website, do not affect its functionality and image, and therefore cannot be considered defects or lack of conformity under the French Consumer Code and any other applicable law, being on the contrary merits that highlight its uniqueness. Each Product is guaranteed by a mark of authenticity together with the progressive number. During purchase, it is not possible to select a specific progressive number for the Product; instead, a number will be automatically assigned to the Product you will receive.

- **2.3** We may change or discontinue a Product or any of its features, as described on the Website, at any time without notice (this does not affect orders for which you have received an Order Acceptance at the time of the change). During the purchasing process, we will inform you if your order cannot be processed due to the unavailability of the ordered Products.
- 2.4 In the event your connection to the Website fails, your selection of Products may be lost. In such case you will be required to re-enter your selection. Please note that Products in your shopping cart are not reserved and may be purchased by other customers. In no event we shall be liable to you for the unavailability of a Product following a failure or loss of your connection to the Website.
- 2.5 The products are manufactured by Zanotta S.p.a., Via Vittorio Veneto 57, Nova Milanese (MB), Italy and imported by BV Ecommerce S.r.l. and Bottega Veneta S.r.l., Località Conti Maltraverso 1. 36054 Montebello Vicentino (Vicenza), Italy.

### 3. PRICES

- **3.1** Prices of Products are indicated on the Website in the currency specified for the country of the shipping destination and are inclusive of any applicable VAT, sales taxes or other taxes. Prices do not include delivery charges which, if any, will be added to the price of the Products and will be communicated to you during the checkout process before you confirm your order (remaining understood that delivery charges may be also equal to zero in case those are sustained by us).
- **3.2** We make all reasonable efforts to ensure that all prices for the Products displayed on the Website are correct. Occasionally, however, an error may occur, and Products may be mispriced (incorrect price or typographical error in the price shown). In this case we may, at our discretion, and prior to the Order Acceptance (i) cancel the order and notify you of such cancellation, or (ii) contact you and ask you whether you wish to purchase the Product at the correct price.
- **3.3** We reserve the right to change the Products prices at any time and without notice, but such changes will not apply to Products for which you have received an Order Acceptance.

### 4. FORMATION OF THE CONTRACT – PLACING AN ORDER

**4.1** To purchase Products on the Website, you must follow the instructions provided by the online purchase process which are: (i) include the selected Products in the shopping cart, (ii) fill in the order form with your personal information (name, address, email, telephone, shipping/billing address), (iii) select your payment method, (iv) accept these General Terms (including the other policies of the Website mentioned herein and incorporated by reference), (v) accept the ToU and (vi) place your order through the Website.

- 4.2 Before submitting your order, you will be given the opportunity to review your selection, check the total price and correct any errors. Please carefully take note of the time of delivery, as per Section 6.4.
- **4.3** Your order constitutes a binding commitment from you regarding the purchase of the Products, under these General Terms, without prejudice to your right of withdrawal under Section 8. By placing an order, you agree to pay the price of the ordered Products.
- **4.4** All orders submitted by you are subject to our acceptance. Once you place your order, we will acknowledge it by email ("<u>Order Confirmation</u>"). This Order Confirmation does not, however, mean that your order has been accepted. We may choose not to accept your order, in whole or in part, without liability to you. Examples of non-acceptance of your orders are as follows:
  - (i) the Products are not available; or
  - (ii) you do not comply with the eligibility conditions set out in Section 1.3; or
  - (iv) we are unable to obtain authorization for your payment; or
  - (v) there is a non-deliberate error in the price displayed; or
  - (vi) reported or suspected fraudulent, illegal or unauthorized activities, including suspected purchases for commercial purposes; or
  - (vii) the delivery address provided by you is not a valid address; or
  - (viii) you have not fulfilled your obligations deriving from a prior contract entered into with us.
- **4.6** The Contract between us and you will only be formed when you receive from us an email notification confirming shipment of your order ("<u>Order Acceptance</u>"). The Order Acceptance (or rejection) will be sent to the email address provided by you in the order. The details of your accepted orders are available under "My Account My Order" section of the Website.
- 4.7 In case of unavailability of one or more ordered Products, we will contact you and inform you of such unavailability. The order will be partially cancelled and you shall pay only the price of the available Product(s).
- **4.8** The Order Confirmation/Order Acceptance will include notably the order number, basic information on the purchased Products, an indication of the price and the shipping address.
- **4.9** Once you receive the Order Acceptance you can no longer cancel or modify your order unless otherwise provided in these General Terms. Dispatched Products can however be returned as set out in Section 8.

# 5. PAYMENT

- **5.1** You must pay the price of the Products (inclusive of applicable VAT, sales taxes or other taxes as per what provided in Section 3.1) and the associated delivery charges, if any.
- **5.2** We accept payments made in the currency specified for the country of the shipping destination, with the payment methods proposed to you before you confirm your order.
- **5.3** We will not debit the amount of your order until:
  - (i) we have confirmed availability of the Product(s);
  - (ii) we have sent you the Order Acceptance;

- (iii) we have received authorization to debit your card from the card issuer or your PavPal account, if applicable:
- (iv) your debit/credit card data or your PayPal account, if applicable, has been verified.
- 5.4 If your payment cannot be processed for any reason, we will cancel your order and our Contract with you will end immediately, without liability to you. We will inform you of this in writing.
- 5.5 You are responsible for the relevant charges or fees, if any, applied by your card issuer, bank or other payment institution as a result of our processing of your payment.
- **5.6** For each order, we will issue an electronic invoice for the purchased Products, and you agree to such form of invoicing. The e-invoice will be established based upon the information provided by you at the time of submitting the order. No alterations to the e-invoice are possible once the e-invoice has been issued.

### 6. SHIPPING, DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

- **6.1** The purchased Products will be delivered exclusively in the country of the shipping destination as indicated by you in the order form, whether applicable.
- **6.2** The purchased Products shall be delivered to you by a courier service selected by us ("<u>Courier</u>"). Products shall be delivered to the address indicated by you in the order form. We are not responsible for any delivery problems arising from incomplete or incorrect address details supplied by you. Please note that we will not deliver to PO boxes, address of freight forwarders or hotels.
- **6.3** The purchased Products will be shipped out only after we receive your payment in full. If we do not receive your payment in full, whatever the reason, we can delay or refuse dispatching the Products without liability to you.
- 6.4 Please note that the time of delivery showed to you during the checkout process might be incorrect and/or may refer to the time of delivery of Bottega Veneta products other than the Products. We recommend you to carefully look at the delivery window which, on the Website and/or during the checkout process, is highlighted as the only one applicable to the Products. More in detail: Products can take more than 30 (thirty) business days to be delivered. We will take all reasonable steps to deliver the purchased Products within such estimated period, except if a force majeure event, an event beyond our reasonable control or any unforeseeable circumstance occurs. If the delivery of the Products has not occurred within 30 (thirty) business days, you will be entitled to cancel the Contract and we shall, without undue delay, refund you all sums paid under the Contract. In case any investigation with the Courier has been opened in relation to the Products, all amounts paid by you to us will be refunded, if applicable, upon completion of such investigation which timing we commit with the Courier to keep as short as possible.
- **6.5** Upon delivery of the Products by the Courier, you (or the person designated by you) are required to:
  - (i) verify that the number of packages delivered corresponds to that indicated on the delivery note;
  - (ii) verify that the packages and their seals are intact, undamaged, not wet or altered in any manner;
  - (iii) verify that the delivered Products conform to the model, colour, size and other characteristics of the Products as described on the Website and in the Order Confirmation/Order Acceptance and that are free from any patent defects (including but not limited to cracks, scratches, colour variations or other colour defects, etc.); and

(iv) sign the delivery note.

Any damages to the packages and/or the Products or discrepancies in the number of packages or documentation or any lack of conformity or patent defects of the Products must be immediately mentioned in writing on the Courier's delivery note. To the extent permitted under applicable laws, once you've signed the Courier's delivery note, you may no longer make a claim with respect to the delivered packages, provided that you are entitled to subsequently make a claim in relation to the lack of conformity and manufacturing defects of the Products as set forth in Section 9 and that you are entitled to use your withdrawal right as set forth in Section 8.

**6.6** You can track the status of your shipment by clicking on the link included in the Order Acceptance.

### 7. RISK AND TITLE

- **7.1** The risk of loss of, damage to, and destruction of, the Products shall pass to you when you (or a person designated by you and other than the carrier) take physical possession of the Products at the delivery address given by you.
- **7.2** Title in the Products shall pass to you on the date on which the Products are delivered to your delivery address.

## 8. RIGHT OF WITHDRAWAL/CANCELLATION AND RETURNS

# **APPLICABLE TO CONSUMER ONLY**

- **8.1** You have the right to withdraw from/cancel the Contract if you change your mind or for any other reason within fourteen (14) days from the date on which you (or the person designated by you) take physical possession of the Products or, in case of multiple packages delivered for the same order, the last package delivered.
- **8.2** To exercise your right of withdrawal, you must inform us of your decision to exercise your right of withdrawal/to cancel the Contract within the period of time mentioned above:
  - A. by sending us by email or by ordinary mail:
    - i) the Model Withdrawal/Cancellation Form set out below, duly filled in and signed by you,

- **8.3** In case you exercise your right of withdrawal/cancellation, you must bear all the relevant costs for returning the Products to us (including, for instance, delivery charges, packaging, securing, any applicable fees, taxes, custom duties). Such costs may be high and may vary depending on several factors (including the number of the Products to be returned, their size, the shipping method, the courier selected, the shipping destination, etc.) from an estimated minimum amount of about 150 € to an estimated maximum of about 350 €. Products shall be returned in their original condition, unaltered, unused and undamaged, in their original packaging and with original tags and labels attached along with all related accessories and documents (e.g. instructions booklet, Product certificates), if any.
- **8.4** You must return the purchased Products within fourteen (14) days from the date you notified us of your decision to exercise your right of withdrawal/right to cancel in accordance with what provided above.
- **8.5** To return a Product, you must contact our Customer Care at +39 02 81 48 19 66 or send an email to <a href="mailto:customercare@bottegaveneta.com">customercare@bottegaveneta.com</a>. Our Customer Care will provide you with the address where the Product has to be returned by you and with the relevant instructions for the return. You will need to contact a courier at your choice and arrange for the Product to be returned. As soon as your Product is dispatched, you must provide the tracking number to our Customer Care at +39 02 81 48 19 66 or send an email to <a href="mailto:customercare@bottegaveneta.com">customercare@bottegaveneta.com</a>.
- 8.6 As we are not liable for return packages that are lost, damaged or stolen in transit, we strongly recommend you to take care by choosing the courier, to add all needed shipping insurances to your package, to make sure to carefully pack the Products, to wrap the Products safely to avoid damage, to place them in their original package and then inside the shipping box in which you received your order as well as to keep your proof of postage to ensure that the Products reach us and are not lost, damaged or stolen in transit.
- 8.7 We will refund you all amounts paid by you to us, the foregoing within fourteen (14) business days from the date we received back from you the Products, including delivery costs (except for any delivery costs greater than the most basic delivery cost offered by us to you at the time of purchase). In case any investigation with the Courier has been opened in relation to the Products, all amounts paid by you to us will be refunded, if applicable, upon completion of such investigation which timing we commit with the Courier to keep as short as possible. Refunds will be made to the original purchaser, in the original method of payment and in the same currency as the of purchase. We will not refund any amounts paid by you to any third party, notably bank or customs charges, if any. Please note that we may reduce your refund to reflect any diminished value of the Products resulting from your handling of the Products other than what is necessary to establish the nature, characteristics and functioning of the Products and, then, you shall be liable for any diminished value of the Products resulting from

the handling of the Products other than what is necessary to establish the nature, characteristics and functioning of the Products.

### 9. LACK OF CONFORMITY - MANUFACTURING DEFECTS

# **APPLICABLE TO CONSUMERS ONLY**

# NO STATUTORY OR CONVENTIONAL WARRANTIES APPLY TO PREFESSIONALS

- 9.1 Products are used goods as they have been used in the setting of the Bottega Veneta Summer 25 fashion show. Subject to what provided under Sections 2.2 and 9.4, if you find that a Product sold by us on the Website has manufacturing defects or is not as described (excluding 1: defects arising from the normal use of the Products during the Bottega Veneta Summer 25 fashion show, 2: any non-conformity to the Order Confirmation/Order Acceptance and 3: those package defects that should have been identified and indicated at the time of delivery pursuant to Section 6.5, to the extent permitted under applicable laws), please contact immediately our Customer Care by calling +39 02 81 48 19 66 or by sending an email to customercare@bottegaveneta.com.
- **9.2** You benefit from a legal warranty for any lack of conformity to the Contract of the Products we have sold to you on the Website as well as a legal warranty of hidden defects in accordance with Article in accordance with Articles 1641 to 1649 of the French Civil.
- 9.3 The used goods warranty covers conformity defects existing at the time of delivery of the Product and manifesting within 24 months from the date of delivery of the Product you purchased, even if the defect was not immediately discoverable on that date. Unless proven otherwise, it is presumed that defects of conformity that become apparent within 12 months from the date of delivery of the used good already existed on that date, unless such a presumption is inconsistent with the nature of the good or the nature of the defect of conformity. As set forth in Article L217-1 and seq. of the French Consumer Code, if the Product you have purchased has a defect covered by the statutory warranty, you have the right, without incurring in any expense, to elect to have the nonconforming good repaired or replaced by us, provided that the remedy you choose is not impossible or, compared to the alternative remedy, does not impose disproportionate costs on us, taking into account the value of the good, the extent of the defect, and the possibility of effecting the alternative remedy without significant inconvenience to you. We may refuse to bring the Products into conformity if, taking into account all the circumstances, repair and replacement are impossible or if the costs that the seller would have to bear are disproportionate. You are entitled to a proportional reduction in the price or termination of the Contract in the following cases: (a) if replacement or repair of the Product is not possible or is excessively onerous; (b) if we have failed to repair or replace the Product within a reasonable period of time; (c) if replacement or repair of the Product has caused you considerable inconvenience; (d) if a lack of conformity becomes apparent, despite our attempt to restore the Product to conformity; and (e) if the lack of conformity is so serious as to justify immediate reduction of the price or termination of the Contract. The price reduction will be proportional to the decrease in value of the Product you received compared to the value Product would have had if Product had been in conformity. To exercise your right to terminate the Contract, you will have to address a statement to us containing an express expression of willingness to terminate the Contract. Please keep in mind that a minor defect for which it was not possible or is unduly burdensome to exhaust the remedies of repair or replacement does not entitle you to terminate the Contract. A statutory disclaimer text explaining your legal rights of consumers in France can be found under Annex I below.
- **9.4** Damage, alteration or modification to the Products caused by you is not a manufacturing defect or a lack of conformity. For example, without limitations, any damage caused by normal use or extensive use, improper use (such as direct exposure to the sun light or heat), non-observance of applicable care, maintenance and/or cleaning instructions, are not manufacturing defects or a lack of conformity. Likewise, in addition to what provided under

Section 2.2, variations in the natural markings or irregularities in the composition or in the design of the Products are inherent to the Product and not manufacturing defects or a lack of conformity.

**9.5** In the event you request the repair, replacement or return of a Product due to lack of conformity or manufacturing defect pursuant to this Section 9, we will bear the delivery costs for returning the Products to be repaired, replaced or returned, as well as any costs to deliver back to you the repaired or replaced Products.

### 10. LIABILITY

# **APPLICABLE TO CONSUMERS ONLY**

**10.1** We will be responsible for any direct loss we cause you, but we will not be responsible for any loss due to an event beyond our reasonable control, such as a force majeure event or a material breach of the Contract by you.

# APPLICABLE TO PROFESSIONALS ONLY

- **10.2** Nothing in these General Terms seeks to exclude or limit our liability for:
  - personal injury or death resulting from our negligence;
  - fraud or gross negligence; or
  - any other cause of action which cannot be limited or excluded under applicable law.
- **10.2** Subject to Section 10.2, our aggregate liability which shall be limited solely to direct damages, caused by our breach, that you suffer in respect of all claims and causes of action, arising under or in connection with these General Terms and each Contract, shall in no event exceed the price of the Product(s) purchased by you on the Website under that Contract. Subject to Section 10.2, we are not liable for damage or loss that either you or we could not reasonably have foreseen at the time you accepted these General Terms. Subject to 10.2, we shall not be liable to you for any indirect damages.
- 10.3 We are not responsible for any delay or failure to perform any of our obligations under these General Terms if the delay or failure is caused by a force majeure event or arises from any cause which is beyond our reasonable control, including without limitation any of the following: act of God, governmental act, war, civil war, fire, flood, earthquake, hurricane and other natural disasters, epidemic, revolution, insurrection, invasion, military or usurped power, confiscations, terrorist activities, national strikes, lockouts, embargo, interruption or failure in information, technology, electricity or telecommunications services, failure of third parties (such as Courier, our suppliers and subcontractors) to perform their obligations to us.
- **10.4** If you do not comply with the eligibility conditions set out in Section 1, we are not liable towards you for any damage or loss caused by us.

### 11. GUARANTEE OF AUTHENTICITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- **11.1** We guarantee the authenticity of all Products purchased on our Website.
- **11.2** Bottega Veneta trademarks, whether figurative or not, service marks, all other marks, brand names, logos used on the Products, the accompanying accessories and/or the packaging, whether registered or not, together with all photographs, illustrations, images relating to the Products, trade or business names, domain names and URL(s) are and remain our exclusive property and/or of our licensors, as applicable, and are protected by applicable copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property laws around the world. Kering Group and we reserve all such rights.

#### 12. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- **12.1** These General Terms and any document expressly referred to in them represent the entire agreement and understanding between us in relation to the sale of Products from us and supersede any prior agreement, understanding or arrangement between us, whether oral or in writing.

### 13. APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION

- **13.1** These General Terms and, therefore, the Contracts entered into with you, shall be governed by and will be interpreted in accordance with the laws of France (without reference to its conflict of law provisions). For professionals, the application of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods is excluded.
- **13.2** Any disputes between us arising out of, or relating to, these General Terms and the Contracts shall be submitted: if you are a professional, to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Paris and, if you are a consumer, to the jurisdiction of the courts of your place or residence or domicile.
- **13.3** If you are a consumer, you may access the European Online Dispute Resolution Platform provided by the European Commission and available at <a href="http://ec.europa.eu/odr">http://ec.europa.eu/odr</a>, for alternative extra-judicial resolution of disputes that cannot be resolved between you and us.

### ANNEX I – FRENCH STATUTORY WARRANTY DISCLAIMER FOR CONSUMERS ONLY

For the purposes of the disclaimer below, "consumer" shall mean "consumer" or "you"; and "professional" or "vendor" shall mean "Bottega Veneta" or "we".

Notwithstanding the disclaimer below, Products being used goods, the presumption of anteriority of the defects is 12 months. In other words, if you wish to invoke the statutory warranty of conformity for a Product purchased more than 12 months ago, you will have to provide proof of the existence of the lack of conformity on the day of sale.

Le consommateur dispose d'un délai de deux ans à compter de la délivrance du bien pour obtenir la mise en œuvre de la garantie légale de conformité en cas d'apparition d'un défaut de conformité. Durant ce délai, le consommateur n'est tenu d'établir que l'existence du défaut de conformité et non la date d'apparition de celui-ci.

Lorsque le contrat de vente du bien prévoit la fourniture d'un contenu numérique ou d'un service numérique de manière continue pendant une durée supérieure à deux ans, la garantie légale est applicable à ce contenu numérique ou ce service numérique tout au long de la période de fourniture prévue. Durant ce délai, le consommateur n'est tenu d'établir que l'existence du défaut de conformité affectant le contenu numérique ou le service numérique et non la date d'apparition de celui-ci.

La garantie légale de conformité emporte obligation pour le professionnel, le cas échéant, de fournir toutes les mises à jour nécessaires au maintien de la conformité du bien.

La garantie légale de conformité donne au consommateur droit à la réparation ou au remplacement du bien dans un délai de trente jours suivant sa demande, sans frais et sans inconvénient majeur pour lui.

Si le bien est réparé dans le cadre de la garantie légale de conformité, le consommateur bénéficie d'une extension de six mois de la garantie initiale.

Si le consommateur demande la réparation du bien, mais que le vendeur impose le remplacement, la garantie légale de conformité est renouvelée pour une période de deux ans à compter de la date de remplacement du bien.

Le consommateur peut obtenir une réduction du prix d'achat en conservant le bien ou mettre fin au contrat en se faisant rembourser intégralement contre restitution du bien, si :

- 1° Le professionnel refuse de réparer ou de remplacer le bien ;
- 2° La réparation ou le remplacement du bien intervient après un délai de trente jours ;
- 3° La réparation ou le remplacement du bien occasionne un inconvénient majeur pour le consommateur, notamment lorsque le consommateur supporte définitivement les frais de reprise ou d'enlèvement du bien non conforme, ou s'il supporte les frais d'installation du bien réparé ou de remplacement ;
- 4° La non-conformité du bien persiste en dépit de la tentative de mise en conformité du vendeur restée infructueuse.

Le consommateur a également droit à une réduction du prix du bien ou à la résolution du contrat lorsque le défaut de conformité est si grave qu'il justifie que la réduction du prix ou la résolution du contrat soit immédiate. Le consommateur n'est alors pas tenu de demander la réparation ou le remplacement du bien au préalable.

Le consommateur n'a pas droit à la résolution de la vente si le défaut de conformité est mineur.

Toute période d'immobilisation du bien en vue de sa réparation ou de son remplacement suspend la garantie qui restait à courir jusqu'à la délivrance du bien remis en état.

Les droits mentionnés ci-dessus résultent de l'application des articles L. 217-1 à L. 217-32 du code de la consommation.

Le vendeur qui fait obstacle de mauvaise foi à la mise en œuvre de la garantie légale de conformité encourt une amende civile d'un montant maximal de 300 000 euros, qui peut être porté jusqu'à 10 % du chiffre d'affaires moyen annuel (article L. 241-5 du code de la consommation).

Le consommateur bénéficie également de la garantie légale des vices cachés en application des articles 1641 à 1649 du code civil, pendant une durée de deux ans à compter de la découverte du défaut. Cette garantie donne droit à une réduction de prix si le bien est conservé ou à un remboursement intégral contre restitution du bien.
